Performance Audit Findings — There were no finding or recommendations related to local school construction bonds for the year ended June 30, 2019. Prior Audit Findings — There were no finding and recommendations for the year ended June 30, 2018. Christy White & Associates issued an unmodified opinion over the financial statements of the Measure B Bond Building Fund.
